



Rules for toilets and latrine on allotment gardens

All allotment gardens with a cabin need to have a dry toilet installed. When you sign your lease with Landskrona stad, a latrine collection subscription is automatically started with the local waste company LSR (Landskrona Svalövs Renhållnings AB) for May-September. If you do not want collection and pay the fee you need to apply for an exemption at the local authority of environmental and health (Miljöförvaltningen).

Alternatives for dry toilets and how to handle the latrine:

Only dry toilets are allowed within the colony areas

All toilets that involve **water or chemicals are prohibited** within the colony areas. Only dry toilets are permitted. If there is no approved toilet on your allotment, you must submit a notification for a permit for installation.

Approved toilets:

- Composting toilet (mulltoa)
- Urine-separating dry toilet
- Incineration toilet

Depending on the type of toilet you must decide how to manage the waste.

Processing fee (2026): **SEK 3,930.**

Exemption alternatives:

1. You want to compost the latrine on site

- You must apply for an exemption within 2 weeks of signing the contract.
- You must describe and present an approved composting solution.

2. You live close or renovate the cabin

- You live within 5 minutes by bicycle (according to Google Maps) and do not need a toilet in the cabin you can apply for exemption. In this case, no toilet may be installed.
- You are not using the cabin for a period (for example, during renovation).

For both exemption applications the fee is **SEK 2,620**.

Note: LSR's basic fee of **SEK 455** (from April 1, 2026) still applies even if the exemption is approved.

How to compost latrine

- Latrine must be stored for at least **2 years** before spreading.
- You need two containers or a composter with two compartments.
- Recommended total volume: about **200 liters** (e.g., 2 × 100 L).
- The composter must have a solid bottom, a lid, and ventilation with mesh.

For an electric driven composting toilet (mulltoa), one composter is sufficient.

Handling Urine

If your toilet separates urine, you must collect it in a container.

Urine can be used as fertilizer. Dilute it with water at a **1:10 ratio** before watering plants.

Separated urine must not be discharged into the drainage water within the allotment area.

Examples of latrine composters

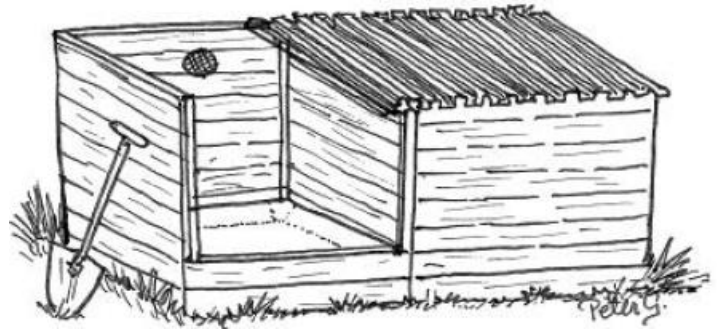
Latrine composter purchased in the market with net and valve

You will need at least two of those if there is only one compartment.



Home construction - two compartments

Bottom: dense and durable material (reinforced plastic or thick rubber cloth) that should go up about 20 cm on the 4 walls of the two compartments. This way two tight vessels are formed at the bottom of each compartment.



Plastic barrel with drilled holes covered with net



This is a latrine composter you easily can make on your own with a plastic barrel, a drill and a piece of net to cover the holes.
